



JESSICA SIMPSON BRINGS COUNTRY TO SAN MANUEL
From Pop Star to Country Music Sensation

Simpson began her performing career by sharing the stage with famous gospel acts. Her unique voice and pop sound caught the eye of Columbia Records executive Tommy Mottola. In 1999, she quickly burst onto the pop music scene with her debut release “Sweet Kisses”. The album went RIAA-certified Double Platinum and featured the breakthrough hit, “I Wanna Love You Forever”, which hit #3 on the Billboard Hot 100 chart.

Simpson also released a follow-up album in 2001 called “Irresistible”, which had numerous chart topping hits. Her album, “In This Skin”, went quadruple-platinum and the single, “Sweetest Sin” hit the Top 40. In addition, Simpson took on Hollywood. She had a recurring role on “That 70’s Show” and had an MTV reality show “Newlyweds: Nick & Jessica” that made her a household name. In 2005, Simpson made her film debut as Daisy Duke in “The Dukes of Hazzard”.

After nearly a decade of success and life in the pop spotlight, Simpson yearned to return to her roots and with her latest album, “Do You Know”, she does just that. The hit single off that album, “Come On Over”, debuted at No. 41 on Billboard’s Hot Country Songs chart, which marks the highest chart debut among a solo artist with no prior history on the country chart.
