Twice, *Rolling Stone* magazine named her Best Female Hip-Hop Artist of the Year, and twice ranked *Billboard* magazine's number one year-end female hip-hop star.

Missy's career is also filled with charitable work for a variety of causes, including domestic violence, aids, teen obesity, and assisting youths in poverty-stricken homes.
