



TRACY MORGAN SET TO BRING LAUGHTER TO SAN MANUEL
Stand-up Comedian and Cast Member of Hit Series “30 Rock”

Morgan’s distinctive voice can be heard as puppet Spoonie Luv, a smooth-talking, hip hop-type character, on “Crank Yankers”. The character often refers to himself as “Spoonie Luv from up above”. Additionally, Morgan serves as the host of the third season of Sci-Fi Channel’s “Scare Tactics”.
